

**BIOGRAPHY**

**MAJOR GENERAL QUAZI MD RASHID-UN-NABI, MBBS, Mphil, MPH**

Major General Quazi Md Rashid-Un-Nabi was born on 02 January 1966 in a respected Muslim family in Khulna, Bangladesh. His father's name is late Quazi Mahbubur Rahman and mother's name is late Noor Jahan Begum. He is promoted to the present rank on 03 December 2023. He assumed the most prestigious & highest appointment of Army Medical Corps of Bangladesh Army, Director General Medical Services (DGMS) on 23 Oct 2024.

Major General Rashid passed SSC in 1980 from St. Joseph's High School, Khulna and HSC in 1982 from Sundarban Adarsh College, Khulna. He obtained MBBS degree from Sher-e-Bangla Medical College, Barisal under Dhaka University in 1990. He was commissioned in the Army Medical Corps (with three years seniority) of the Bangladesh Army on 09 July 1991. He successfully completed all the compulsory Army Courses including BMTC Course from BMA. Later, he completed Masters of Public Health in 2011 under Bangladesh University of Professionals with first position. He earned MPhil in Healthcare & Hospital Management under Bangladesh University of Professionals in 2018. He participated in various trainings and seminars at home and abroad including participation in the Third International Disaster and Military Medical Conference held in Germany and conference of Drug Administration's held in New Delhi, India organized by World Health Organization (WHO).

Major General Rashid served as Medical Officer in various units of Bangladesh Army, Border Guard Bangladesh and Cadet College. He served Bangladesh Army's 61 Field Ambulance and CMH Syedpur as Commanding Officer. Served as Commandant CMH Jashore, ADMS 19 Infantry Division, Deputy Commandant Armed Forces Medical Institute. He also successfully served as Director of Kurmitola General Hospital and Sir Salimullah Medical College under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. He also served as Commandant Armed Forces Medical College and Director General Drug Administration. He has successfully served as Medical Officer in BANBAT-2 (UNAMSIL), Sierra Leone and MMRLU-1 (UNAMID), Sudan as part of United Nations peacekeeping missions keeping the honor of the country. He has visited Sierre Leone, Sudan, Saudi Arabia, Germany, Australia, Singapore and India. These experiences have enriched his understanding of global health issues and enhanced his professional development.

Apart from administrative duties, he has also been successful in academic activities. He has published 3 self-authored journal articles and many co-authored journal articles in Sir Salimullah Medical College Journal, Armed Forces Medical College and Kurmitola General Hospital Journal.
