

# SCIENTIFIC ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear Colleagues and Friends,

It is my honor and pleasure to extend you an invitation to attend the 6th ICMM PAN-ASIA PACIFIC CONGRESS ON MILITARY MEDICINE which will take place in June, 2025 in Beijing, China.

The main scientific theme of the Congress is “Innovation, Cooperation, Development, Together for a Shared Future”.

The Scientific Program Committee would therefore like to take this opportunity to invite you to submit an abstract.

Topics can include but are not limited to:

**1st topic: Innovation of health service and administration.**

**Including:** development and innovation of health service system and administration; comprehensive support for disaster medical rescue; military medical education, training and simulation; artificial intelligence empowers military medicine.

**2nd topic: Improvement of combat casualty care. Including:**

pre-hospital casualty care techniques and equipment; new techniques and methods of clinical specialized treatment; application of traditional medicine in combat casualty care (traditional Chinese medicine, acupuncture and moxibustion); new technology and products for battlefield blood support; military psychological stress

and protection.

**3rd topic: Prevention and control of regional infectious diseases. Including:** transnational cooperation and support for the prevention and control of major global epidemics; new technologies and methods for the prevention and control of regional emerging infectious diseases; drug and vaccine research and development and cooperation.

**4th topic: Special medicine and operational medical support. Including:** detection techniques for chemical weapons; prevention and treatment techniques of nuclear and radiological injury; health protection of soldiers in extreme operating environments.

All military medical professionals are invited to submit abstracts before 28 February, 2025. Scientific papers must represent original works categorized in any of the 4 fields noted above. The Congress Scientific Committee (CSC) will select papers for presentations on the basis of these abstracts. Detailed summaries of the papers are accepted for publication in the Congress Abstracts Book.

**INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS**

- All material intended for presentation in the 6th Pan-Asia Pacific Congress on Military Medicine, organized under the aegis of the International Committee of Military Medicine, should be submitted to:

- Authors submitting an abstract do not need to be registered participants.
  - Authors presenting abstracts must be registered participants (an accepted abstract does not give you free registration).
  - The form has to be completed by the first author: full name(s), military rank, professional titles, institution, city, country of the author(s) should accompany each contribution. Underline the speaker's name.
  - The Congress Scientific Committee may require authors to justify the assignment of authorship.
  - All partial or complete reproductions of an article, which has been presented in the 6<sup>th</sup> Pan-Asia Pacific Congress on Military Medicine, are submitted to the previous agreement of the International Committee of Military Medicine.
  - Manuscripts should be typewritten on one side only, single-spaced throughout, in standard 10-point Times font, with no spaces between paragraphs, a 3 cm margin at the left hand side and a maximum of 300 words. Abstracts should be submitted as a RTF (Rich Text Format) file. It should be submitted on line via E-mail: [icmmxu@outlook.com](mailto:icmmxu@outlook.com), or via postal service on CD-Rom to the above address.
- The summary has to be submitted only in one of the three working languages of the International Committee of Military Medicine: English, French or Spanish.
- No charts, pictures or photos are allowed in the abstract.
  - The title should indicate the content of the abstract in a concise manner.
  - Three to five keywords should be provided in order to assist indexers in cross-indexing the presentation.
  - Abbreviations should be avoided in the text, except for accepted scientific units of measurements (SI units). Other abbreviations, if used, should be spelt out in full when first mentioned in the text.
  - Any abstract that does not conform to instructions will be returned to the author(s).
  - Abstracts sent by fax will not be considered.
  - The number of abstracts submitted per author is not limited; however, the author has to guarantee that if selected, the presentation will be made.
  - Abstracts not selected for oral presentation will automatically be considered for poster presentation
  - After an abstract has been accepted, regular papers of about eight to ten pages, including all figures, tables and references have to be submitted to the Congress Scientific Committee in order to be eligible for publication in the International Review of the Armed Forces Medical Services, official review of the International Committee of Military Medicine.
